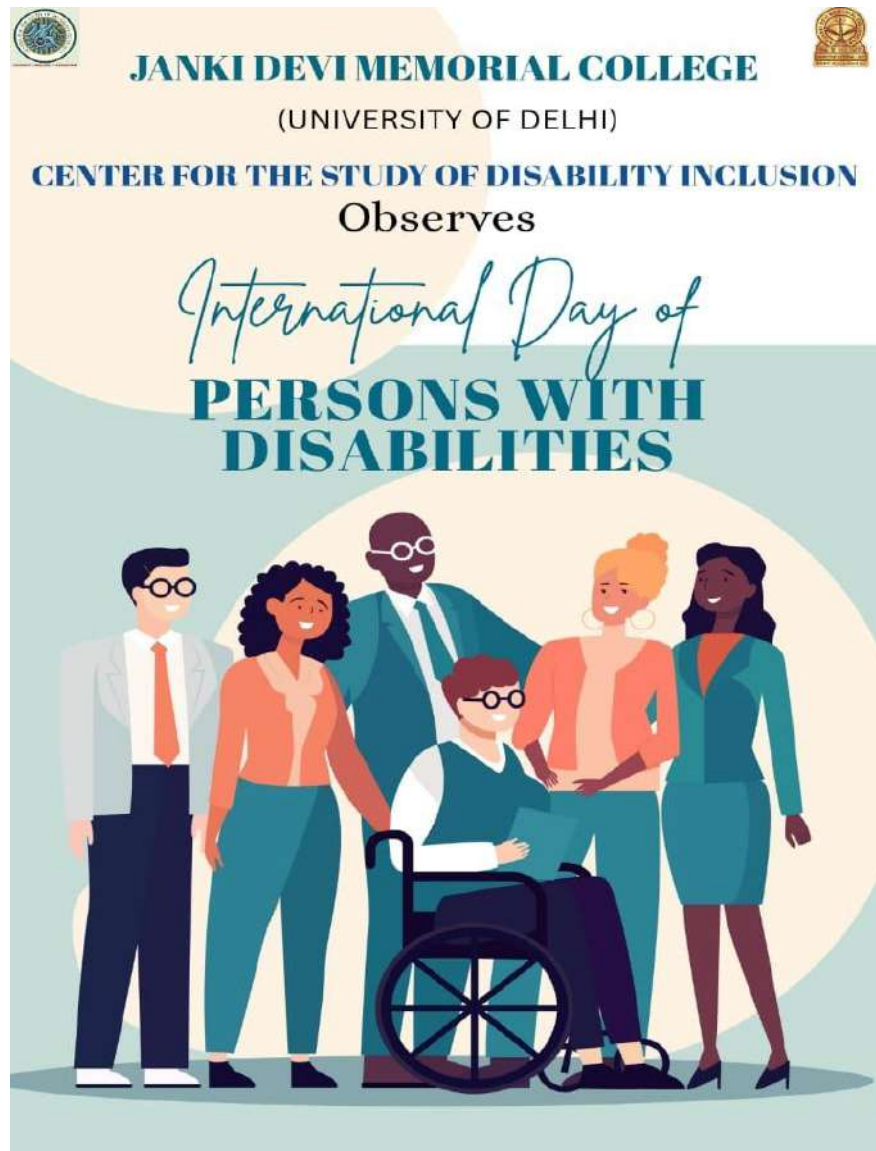
The Centre for Study of Disability Inclusion observed the International Day of Persons with Disabilities on 3 December by sharing an audio described poster on Multiple Disabilities including Deaf Blindness. The aim of this activity was to help students understand what multiple disabilities mean and why accessible communication is important for everyone.

The poster explained the condition in simple words and also included QR codes that students could scan to learn more. An audio description was added so that students with visual difficulties could understand the content clearly and independently. This small step showed how accessibility can help more people participate and feel included.

The poster was shared across several college WhatsApp groups including class groups of first second and third year, society groups and the Saksham and CSDI groups. It was also posted on the official Instagram and Twitter pages of CSDI to reach a wider audience. Teachers and student leaders supported the initiative by forwarding it within their circles.

Students responded warmly and appreciated the effort. The activity reminded everyone that inclusion starts with everyday actions and that accessible communication holds real value in creating an equal and understanding environment for all.

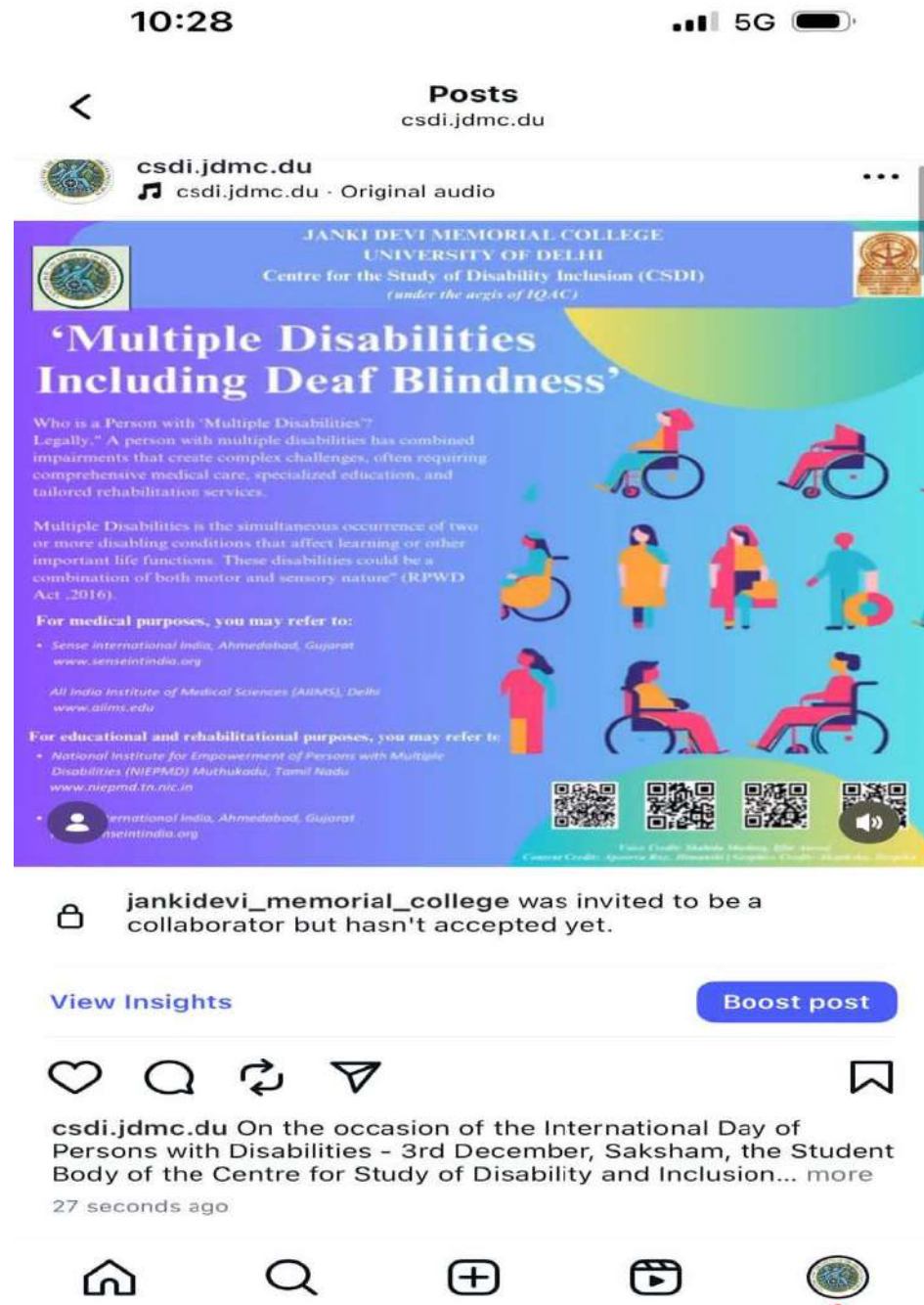

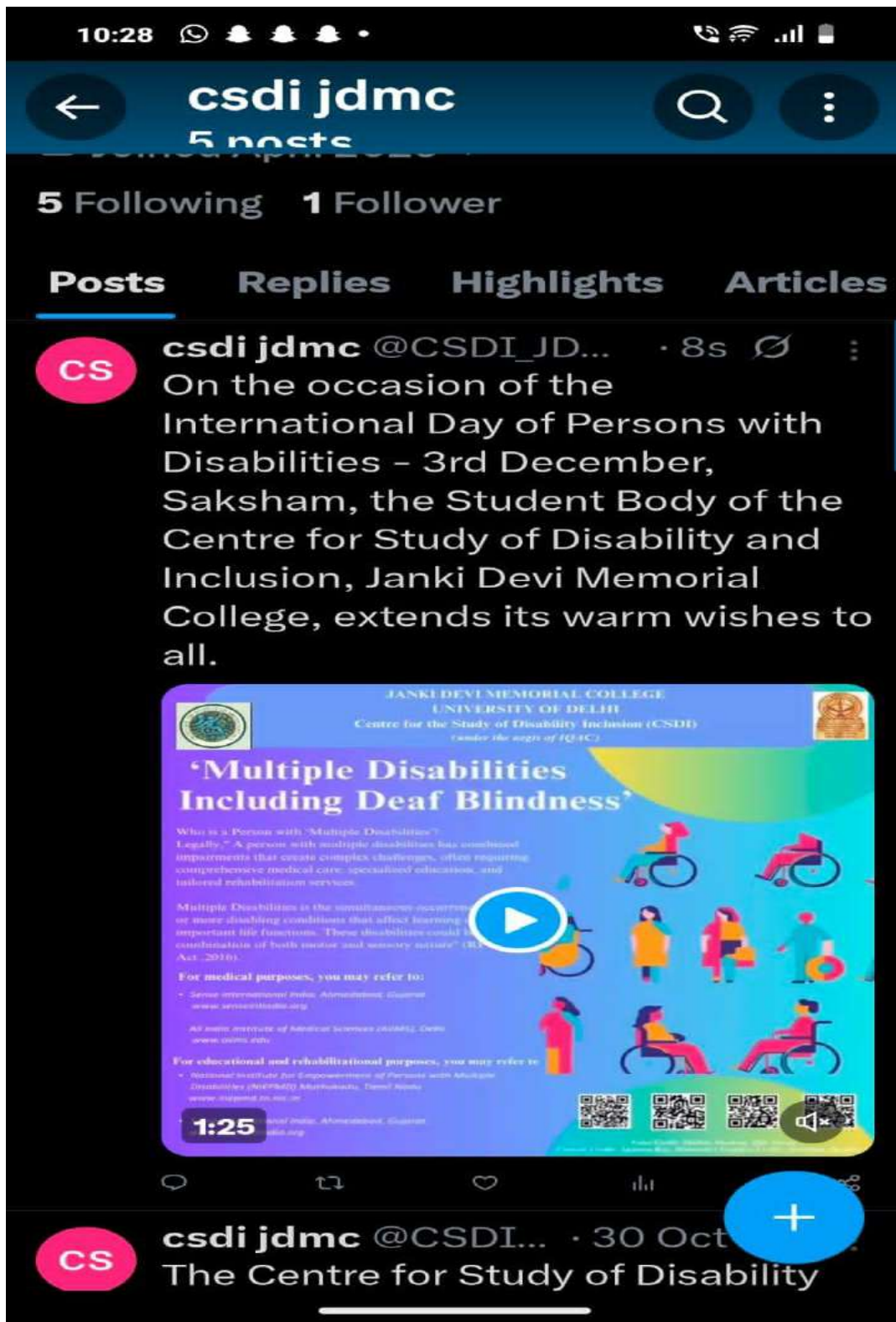

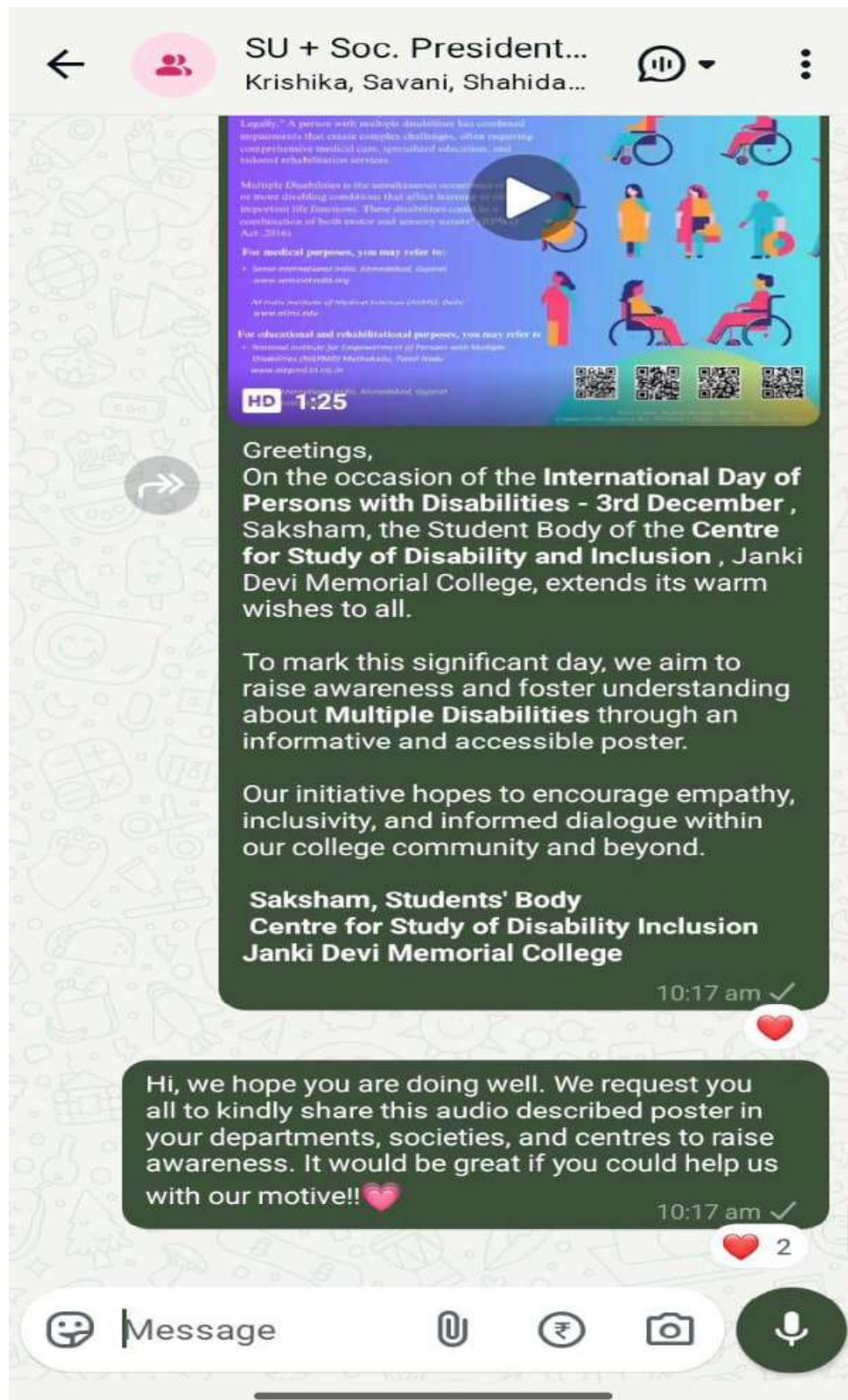

Objectives of the event	The event aimed to raise awareness and promote social inclusion for individuals with visual, hearing, and locomotors disabilities through bystander assistance.

The event titled "Bystander Assistance for Social Inclusion" was held at Janki Devi Memorial College, University of Delhi on 29 October 2025 in Room no 66 under the aegis of the IQAC. Organized by the Centre for Study of Disability Inclusion in collaboration with the Department of English. The event was inaugurated by Dr. Md. Zubeer Ahmed, served as a resource person for the event. The focus was on supporting persons with visual impairment, those who are hard of hearing, and those with locomotor disabilities.

The session emphasized the correct social protocols and terminology to be used when interacting with persons with disabilities (PwDs), aiming to foster a respectful and inclusive environment. Md. Zubeer Ahmed echoed his sentiments. Key points discussed included avoiding outdated and inappropriate terminology, such as "invalid" or "handicapped," and instead focusing on respectful language that upholds the dignity of PwDs.

The event also provided specific guidelines for assisting persons with visual impairments, hearing impairments, and locomotor disabilities. Participants were educated on the importance of appropriate interaction, such as maintaining eye contact, avoiding unnecessary physical contact with assistive devices like wheelchairs, and being mindful of the

surroundings that could pose hazards to PwDs. Apoorva Roy, the President of Saksham Students' Union, demonstrated Indian Sign Language (ISL), covering the alphabets, numbers and some basic words and phrases. Students enjoyed the session and took part in the ISL demo. It showed how small actions can make communication more inclusive.

Overall, the event highlighted the vital role of bystanders in advocating for accessible public spaces and promoting inclusivity. It encouraged participants to become active bystanders who not only assist but also educate others about the importance of social inclusion for persons

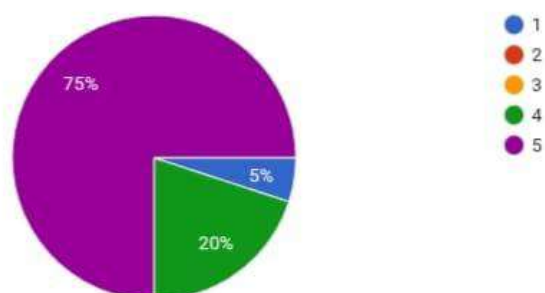

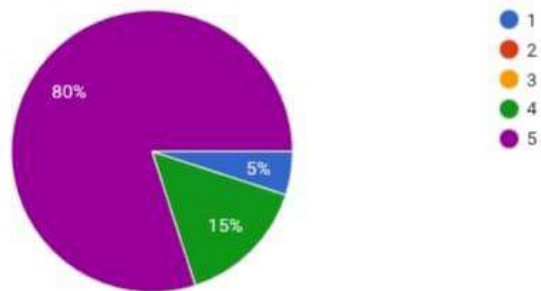

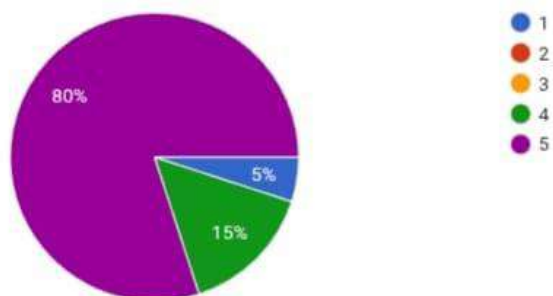

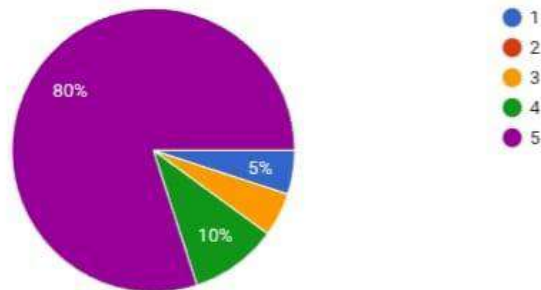

The Centre for Study of Disability Inclusion (CSDI) organized a demonstration on the "Accessible Voting Process" on 13th October 2025, from 11:00 AM to 12:30 PM in the Research Room. Dr. Md. Zubeer Ahmed and Dr. Raju Kesari served as the Resource Persons for this event.

The core objective of the demonstration was to showcase how an inclusive software interface can significantly enhance the accessibility of the electoral process for persons with visual impairment. By using this interface, voters could audibly access the complete list of candidates and cast their vote independently. Furthermore, a printed record of the cast vote was made available immediately afterward. The team also arranged two separate accessible ballot boxes with labels in Braille script.

This demonstration successfully conveyed how a small, inclusive action can create a real-world impact in the lives of persons with visual impairment. The demonstration highlighted the crucial need to integrate accessible elements into such a significant

democratic practice, ensuring that every individual can exercise their electoral rights with ease. All participating faculty members showed an overwhelming positive opinion, enthusiastically engaging with the demonstration and supporting the goal of making our electoral process fully accessible.

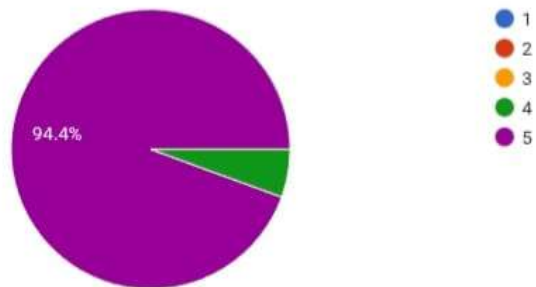

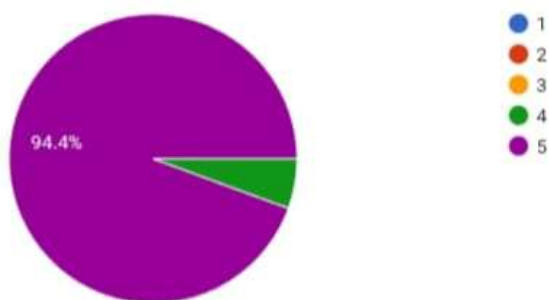

Students, along with professors, explored various stalls and gained insights into the tools and devices that have been developed. Our students enthusiastically learned how small initiatives can promote inclusivity in society. Several booths were installed, presenting tools designed to address different disabilities by WheelEase, HCL Tech, Madras Dyslexia Association, Vision Empower Trust, and others.

Booths like Panoculon Labs showcased their AI-powered smart glasses for persons with visual impairments. These glasses use artificial intelligence and open-air speakers to provide assistance to visually challenged individuals. Another booth, Madras Dyslexia Association, displayed their innovative teaching methods and worksheets through which they make learning fun and engaging for students with intellectual challenges.

The visit offered a comprehensive understanding of how developing innovative tools and mechanisms can make inclusivity more accessible and achievable. It provided valuable exposure to the intersection of technology and social responsibility, inspiring students to think critically about designing a more inclusive future through their own disciplines and initiatives.

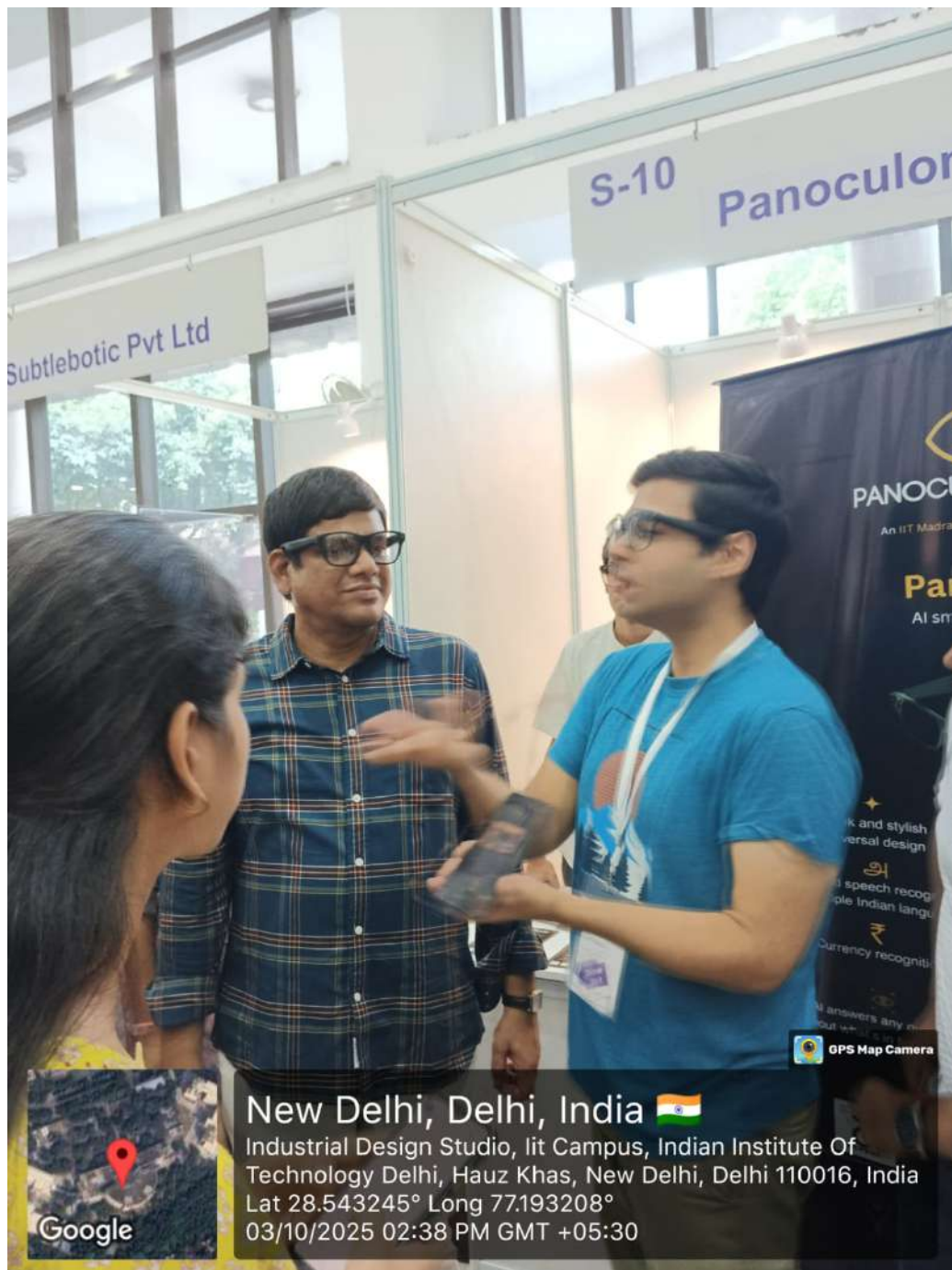

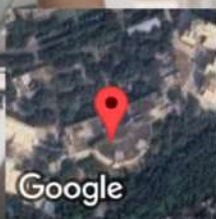
