In India 1.7% of the total child population comprises of children with disability. Three fourths of these children with disabilities are in the age group of early childhood years and one-fourth between 5-19 years. There are challenges in their early detection and school enrolment. These challenges are more to do with reasons as people not aware of their needs or not being able to adapt or accommodate for them than their disability. Passage of numerous laws as PWD Act, RTE will not reap benefits, till the attitudes towards them are addressed. This includes the attitudes of teachers towards including the children with disabilities and the attitudes of parents towards schools ability to address their child's needs. It is time we all decode disability as diversity in human form and understand the potentials that children with disabilities have. What they need is not always our sympathy but an equitable chance to ensure everybody achieves their full potential.

In this spirit, the Human Development and Family Empowerment Department of two esteemed colleges of Delhi University namely Janki Devi Memorial College and Aditi Mahavidyalaya came forward to collaborate and conduct a Certificate course of 30 hours duration on 'Decoding Disability in Children' from February 2021 to March 2021. The teacher coordinators for this course were Ms. Nirmala Muralidhar (Department of HDFE, Janki Devi Memorial College) and Dr. Reema Lamba (Department of HDFE, Aditi Mahavidyalaya).

The Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) was made on 18th January, 2021 between Janki Devi Memorial College, University of Delhi, Sir Ganga Ram Hospital Marg, New Delhi- 110060 and Aditi Mahavidyalaya, University of Delhi, Bawana. New Delhi-110039.

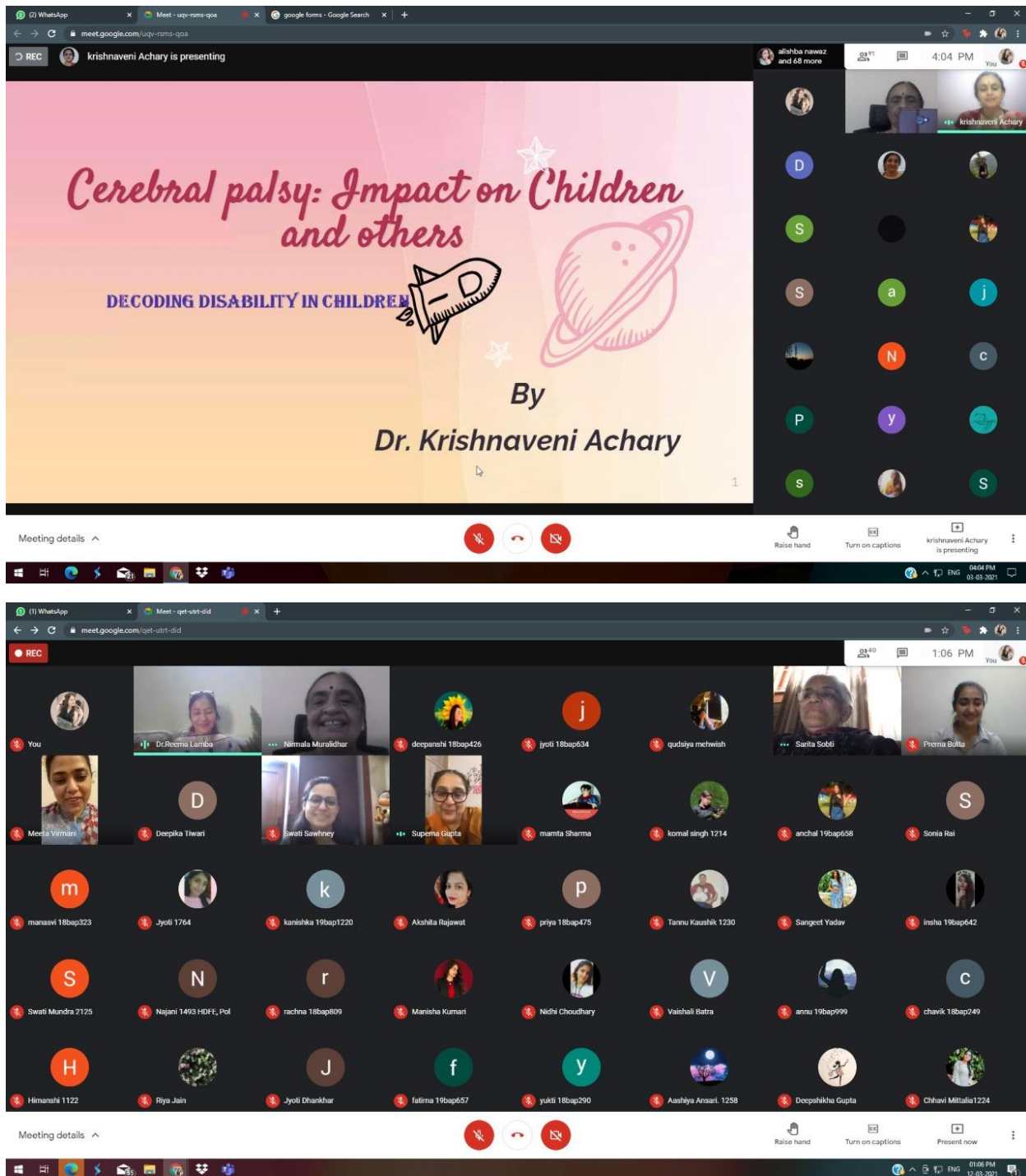

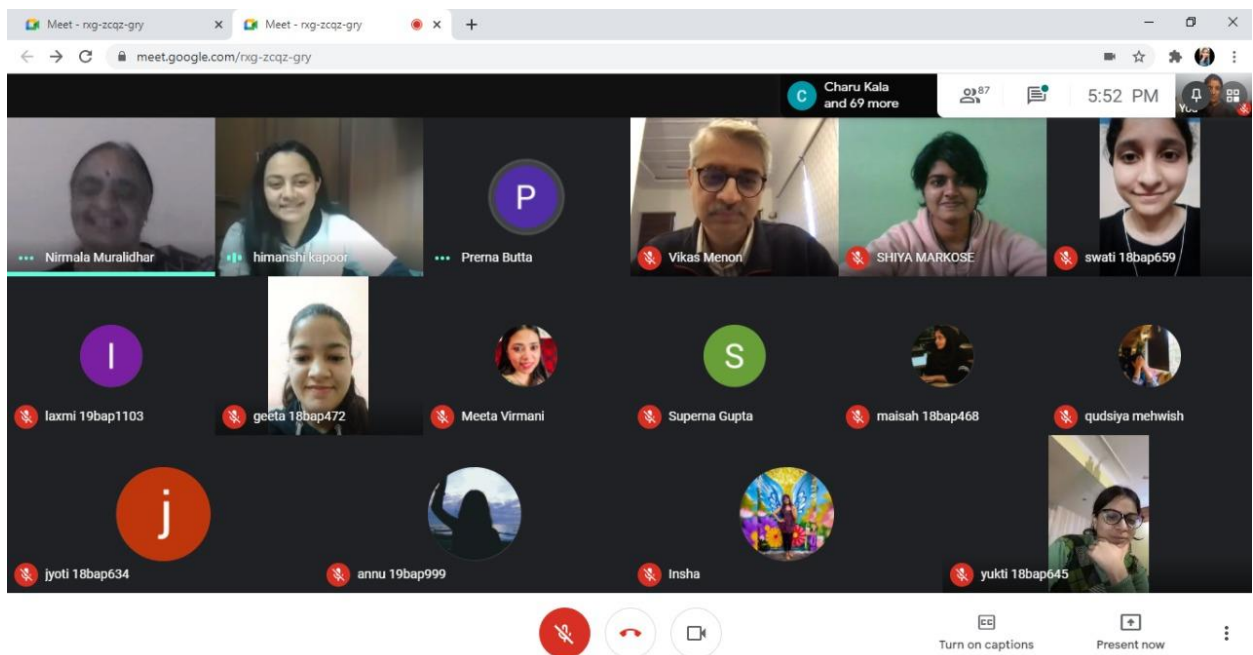

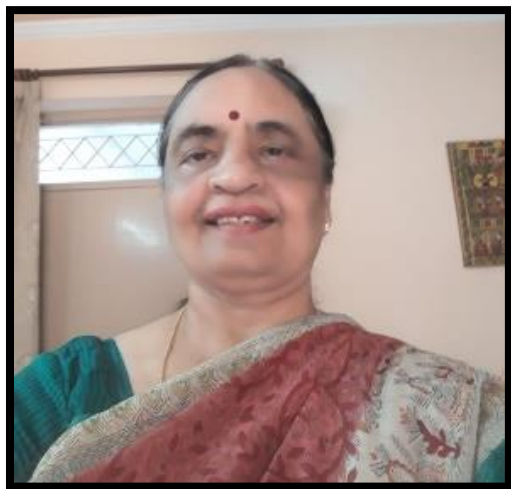
