1. Brief Report

The course ‘Gender Health and Social Work’, by Department of History Janki Devi Memorial College commenced on 15th January 2022 and concluded on 31st May, 2022. The course focused on understanding connections between gender, health and the social sector. A total of 18 students across the country participated in the online course and received the E- certificates. The course consisted of three modules especially designed to prepare the students for the Non- government sector by understanding collaborative work between the government and NGO’s. The course enhanced the ability of the students with respect to health and gender. It especially focused on soft skills such as conversation skills and how to conduct fieldwork on

ground. Dr. Rani Rohini Raman who specialises in the field of Gender, Health and Social Work was the resource person for the course. The course concluded with an online exam and an internal assessment of 25 marks based on class participation in which all the students participated.

2. Outline and Outcome of the Course:

We have successfully completed the course in which 18 students from across university and colleges of other states participated. Students performed very well and received A plus grades for their wonderful performance in the online exam of 75 marks. The classes were highly interactive with discussions and debates. The various outcomes of the course helped students to learn

- a) What is the relation between Gender and the Health Sector
- b) What are the different organisations involved in the process.
- c) Basic aspects of Gender and health were taught in the course.
- d) Which NGOS are involved in this area was discussed and told to the students.
- e) How to conduct fieldwork on ground.
- f) Soft skills such as communication skills and how to make a rapport while conducting fieldwork was taught in the last module.

3. Evaluation Method

Online examination of 75 marks was held (MCQ based, Short Answer and a 25 marks Essay was given to the students). 25 marks were kept for class participation. At the end of the course, grades were awarded to the students on the basis of their performance in the exam. E- certificates provided to the successful candidates.

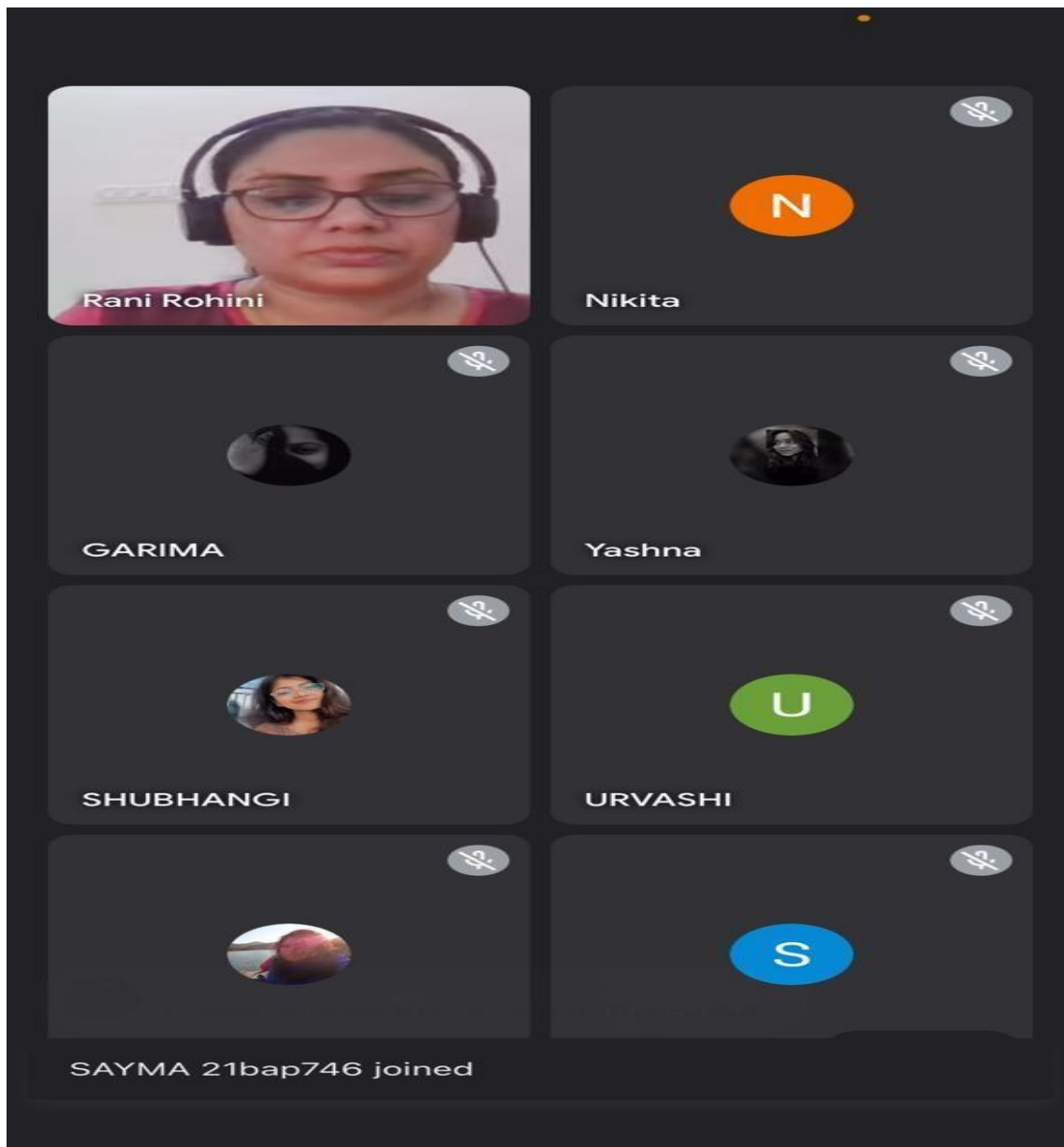

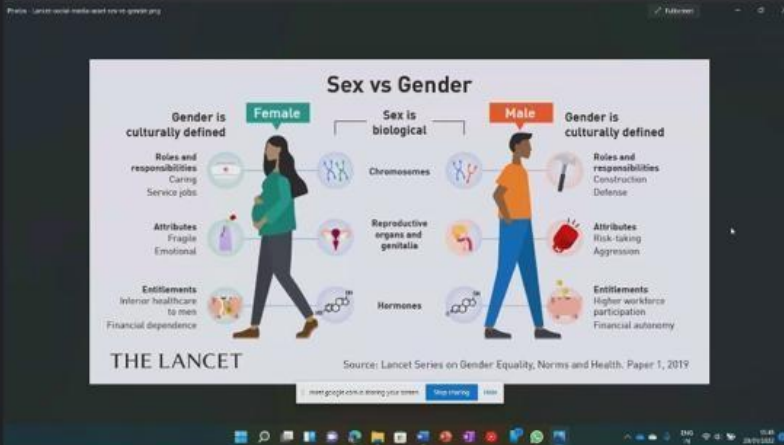

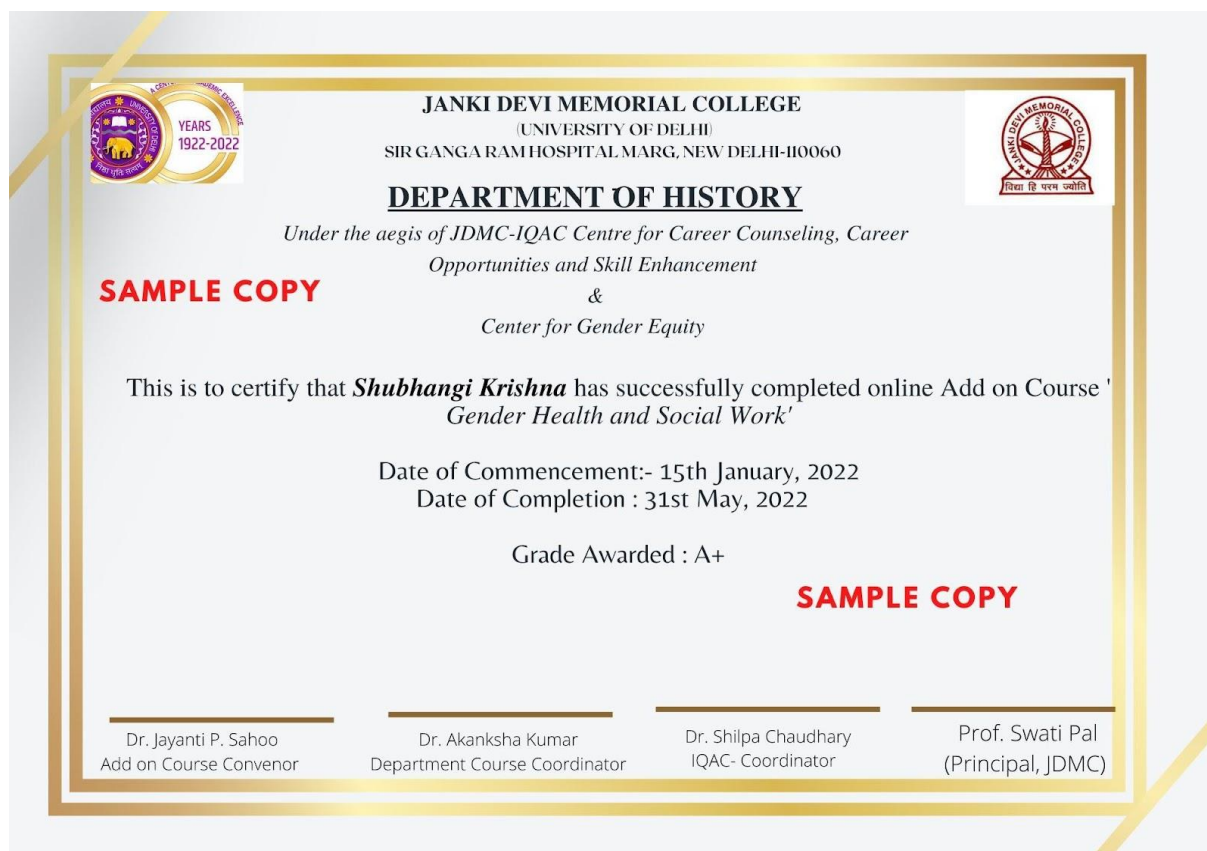
