PRATIBHA: Foundation Classes (Competitive exams)

Janki Devi Memorial College (JDMC), University of Delhi, under Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) has successfully completed the fifth batch of Pratibha: Foundation Classes (competitive exams) under the convenorship of Dr. Md. Zubeer Ahmed and members; Ms. Khachungla Chahang, Dr. Debahuti Brahmachari, Mr. Ahirrao Dinesh Bharat, Mr. Raju Keshari and Dr. Pavan Kumar. Those students who are aiming to clear the various competitive exams conducted by the UPSC, State Public Service Commissions, Universities etc. opted for these classes. The primary objective of these foundation classes was to provide the basic knowledge about important topics from examination point of view, and orient the students to explore further on their own. The topics for lectures were selected keeping in mind the general studies component of various competitive exams.

The classes began in August 2021. 58 students including 10 from Mahatma Gandhi Government College, Mayabunder, Andaman, under Vidya Vistar Scheme of University of Delhi had registered for the classes. The course was divided into 81 modules covering the broad areas of History, Economics, Political Science, Sociology, English, Mathematics, Geography, Science & Technology, Current Affairs, Essay writing and components of Personality test. The classes were taken by the successful candidates in the Civil Services exam, faculties from various departments of the college and experts from the outside. Four modules of two hours each were discussed in a week.

Owing to the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic, the lectures were delivered in online mode through Google Meet platform. Five mock tests, five mock tests discussions and two mentoring/guidance sessions were held to assess students' learning and performance, and to provide tips to solve the questions asked in various competitive exams.

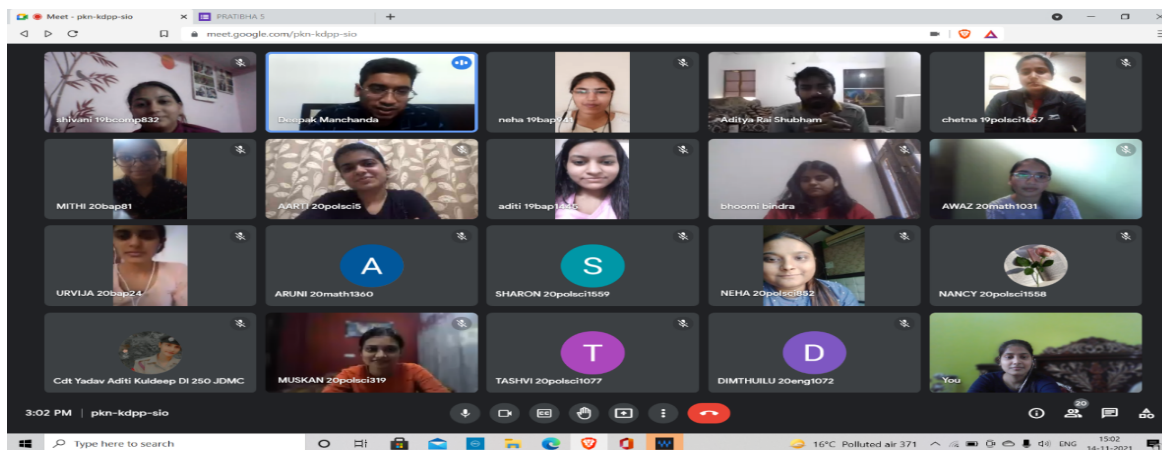
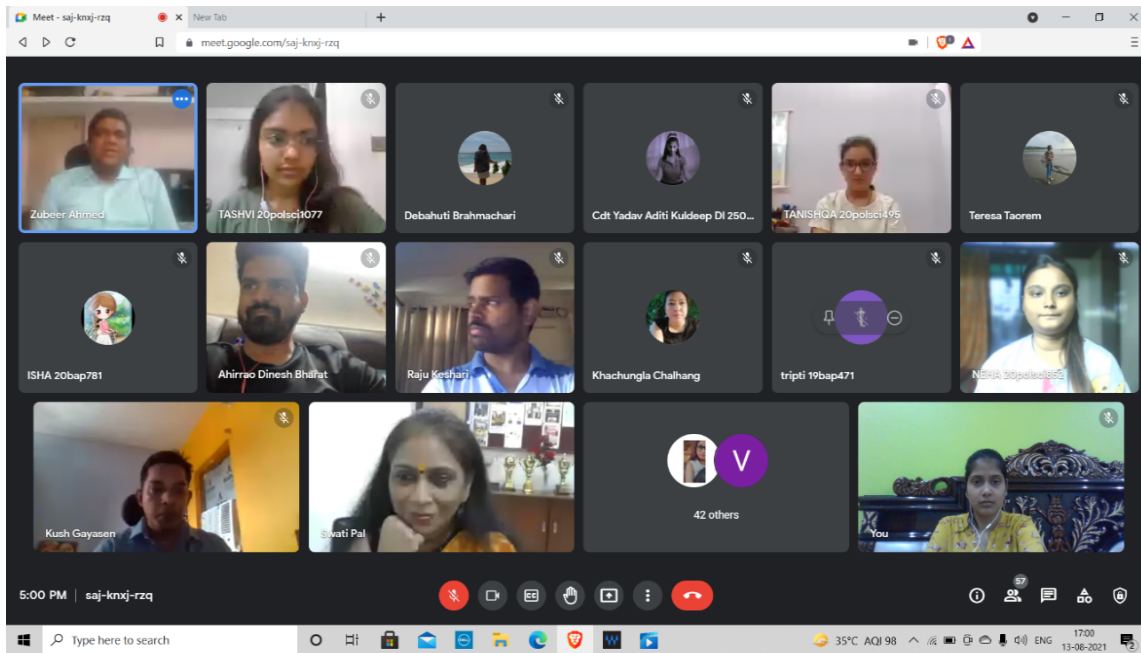

- Important information for exam**
 - Recently, new menhirs were found on the Pothumala hills on the Kerala-Tamil Nadu border.
 - Menhirs are megalithic sites that are erected above the ground and may be small or gigantic in height.
 - Pothumala hills houses hundreds of cobbled stone structures, pointing to the existence of a structured graveyard of a prehistoric civilisation dating back around 3,000 years.
 - These menhirs are the largest ever recorded Menhirs in Kerala.
 - Menhirs are endemic to certain regions only and are a feature of megalithic culture.
- Megalithic culture in India**
 - Megalithic culture refers to the cultural remains found in the megaliths and from the habitation sites associated with them.
 - Megaliths include different kind of monuments that have one thing in common they are made of large, roughly dressed slabs of stones.
- CHALKHANI STUPA**
 - Recently, Chalkhandi Stupa has been declared site of national importance by the Archaeological Survey of India (ASI).
 - It is an ancient Buddhist site in Saranath (Uttar Pradesh), with a lofty brick structure crowned with an octagonal stupa.
 - Originally stupa is said to be built by Emperor Ashoka.
 - The octagonal tower on top is a **Megalith** monument built in 1588 to commemorate Munir Khan's visit to this place.
- Saranath**
 - Saranath had been referred as 'Migdalava' meaning 'deer park' and 'Tigrahar' denoting the place where holy men fell to earth.
 - Lord Buddha delivered his first sermon after attaining enlightenment in Saranath called **dhammachakka - pravartana**.
- Ukuruthi Stupa (Dharmachakra Stupa)**
 - It is the place where Lord Buddha had given his first sermon of Dharma. It is said to have been built in the year 500 CE while the construction was ordered by Emperor Ashoka in the 3rd Century BC.
 - Mahagandhakuti Vihara** This is the place where Lord Buddha lived when he visited Saranath.
 - Rudhi Treegayaashilin** It is located near to the Mahagandhakuti Vihara, planted by taking a branch from
