The Environment Club, Avani under the aegis of JDMC-IQAC Centre for Universal Values and Ethics and Career Counselling, Career Opportunities and Skill Enhancement, Janki Devi Memorial College conducted a 30-Hour Add-on Course titled STRIKING A BALANCE: ENVIRONMENT AND SOCIETY from January-April, 2022.

The aim of the course was to create awareness and an understanding of the important need to strike the right balance between living with the environment and living in the environment.

It consisted of three modules namely Water Management and Greenery, Waste Management and Energy Conservation. There were 22 participants for the course.

The inaugural session was taken by Ms. Sudeshna Saha, Senior Fellow at Centre for Civil Society. The other key resource persons for the various sessions of the course were Dr. Bezwad Wilson(Founder, Safai Karamchari Andolan), Mr. Sanjay Gupta, Dr. Uttam Sinha, Ms. Parul Sethi(NGO, Edible Roots Foundation) and Mr. Vineet Vohra(Give Me Trees Trusts). The sessions were insightful and interactive. 13 participants successfully completed the course of which 5 were offered internships at the collaborating organisations.

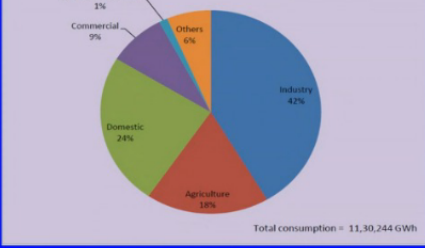

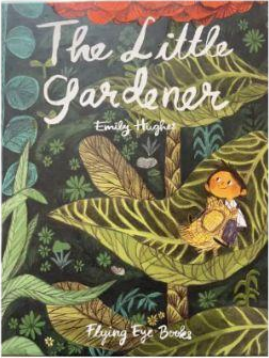
