The average performance of the foundation classes was found ranging good to excellent in terms of score. But in a few areas, it was observed average. Scope of improvement in terms of score was noticed in some areas such as students' participation in the class as the score can be improved for excellent grades.

Students expressed that the foundation classes were very satisfactory and provided them with an enriching experience. These classes helped them in building a foundation for competitive exams as well as provided an understanding about how to approach the different topics and questions. 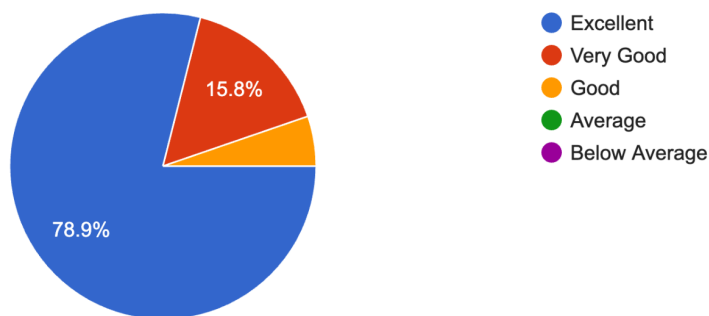

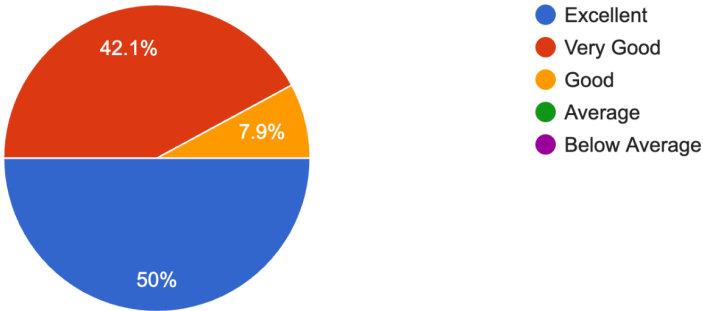
1. Punctuality of teachers in the Class

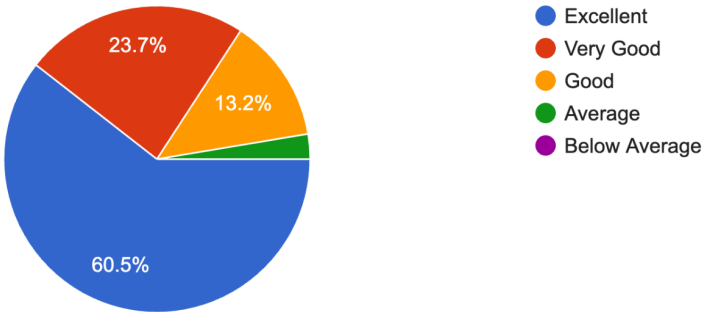
2. Topics completed in time

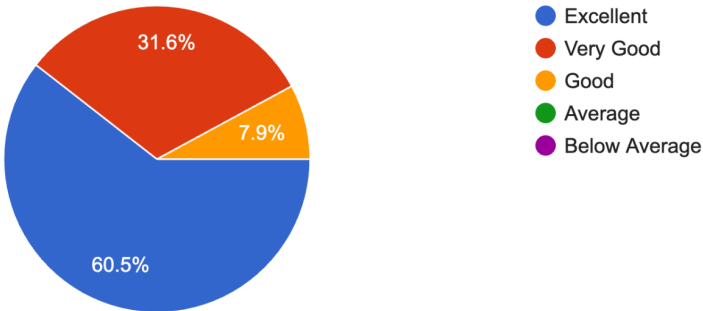
3. Classes met the objectives of competitive exams

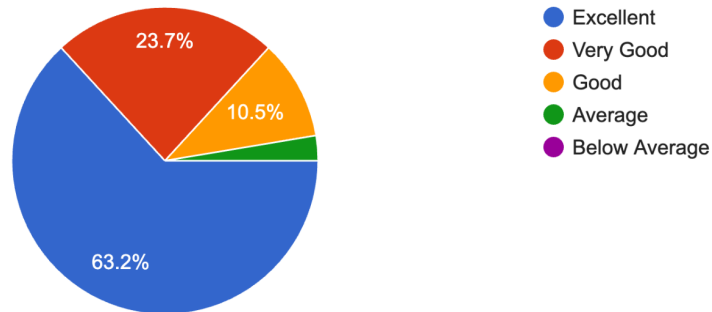
4. Communication skills of teachers

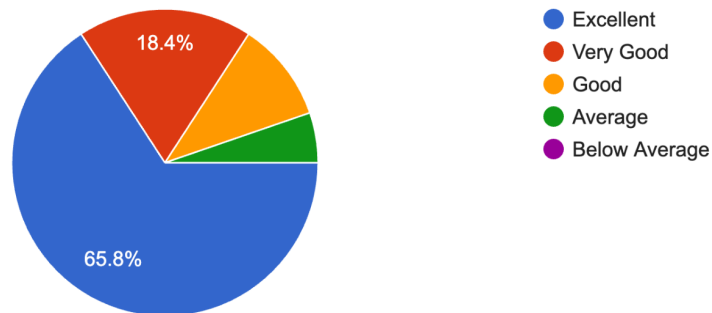
5. Interaction of teachers with students in the lecture

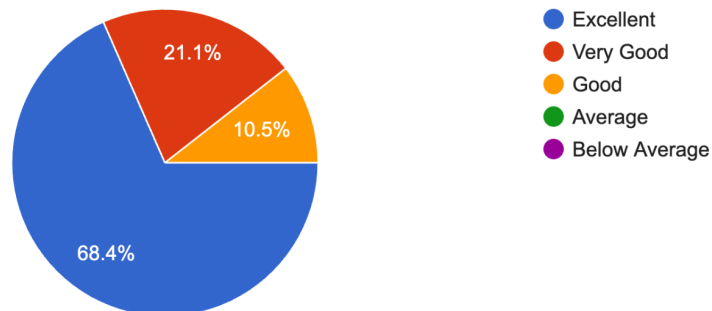
6. Delivery of structured lectures

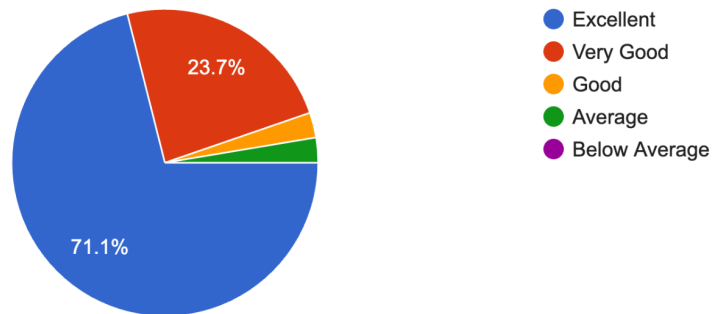
7. Skill of teachers of orienting students for competitive exams

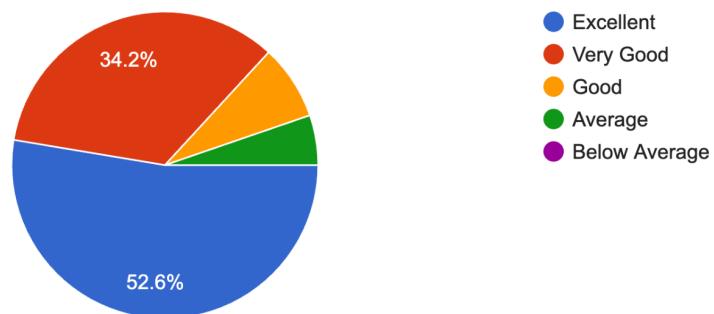
8. Focus on latest developments in the concerned topic

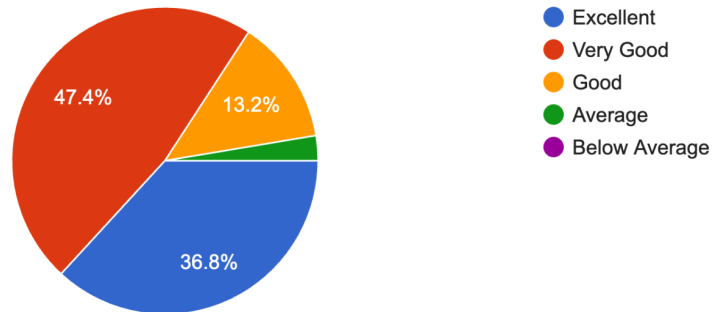
9. ICT methods (PPT) in the lectures used

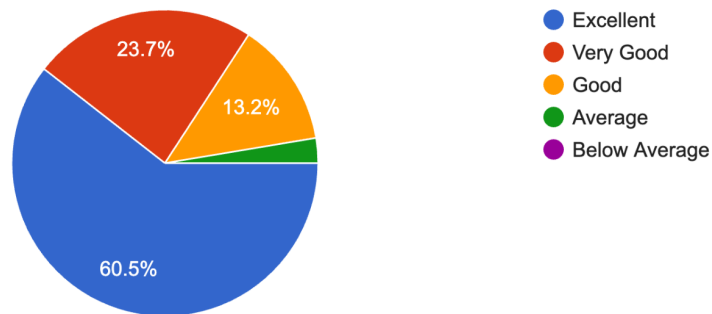
10. Innovative teaching methods used

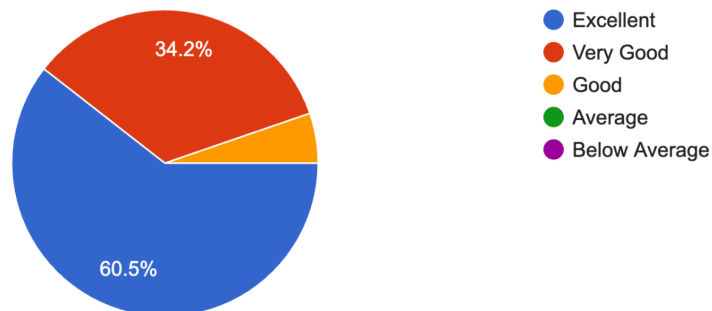
11. Teachers made sure that students understand the concerned topic

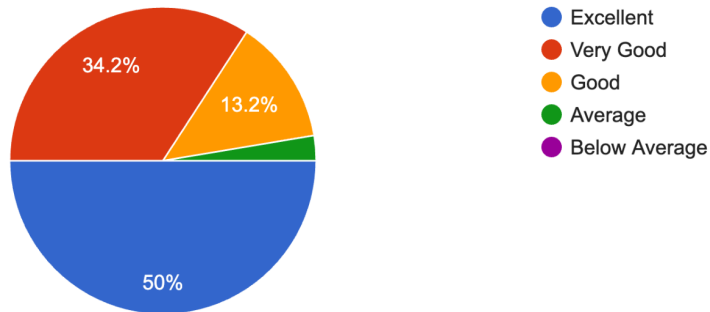
12. Guided students to find relevant study materials for competitive exams

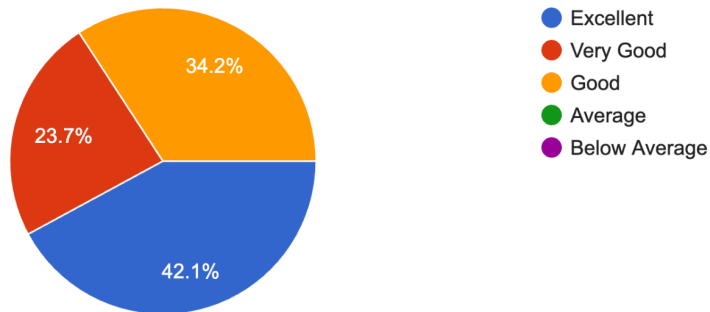
13. Helped students in realizing career goals

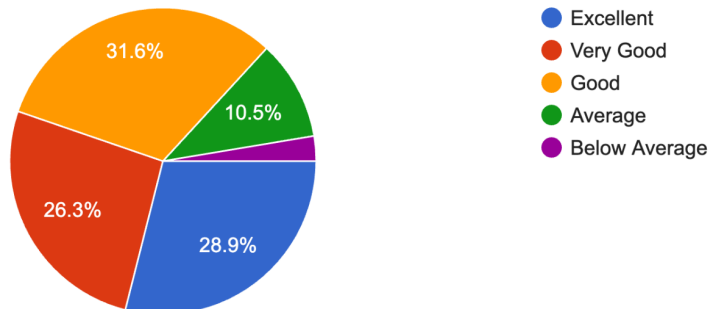
