Action Plan 2023-2024

- The Centre aims to create an awareness about various aspects related to gender studies in students through various activities.
- The Centre will conduct group discussions every fortnight on varied significant topics related to gender so as to give students an avenue to express themselves and to learn more about issues pertaining to gender via interaction with their peers.
- In October, a three day workshop on a relevant topic will be conducted by the Centre for students.
- The Centre will organise talks, lectures and seminars given by experts in different fields related to gender studies so as to make students more aware about various relevant gender issues.
- The Centre will organise film screenings which represent child abuse and child sexual abuse and encourage a discussion of these relevant and sensitive issues.
- The Centre will organise interactions for students with various state and national run NGOs which focus on dealing with cases of child abuse and child sexual abuse so that they can have a comprehensive understanding of this highly sensitive issue.
- The Centre will attempt to collaborate with various organisations working on gender related areas so as to provide students an opportunity to join internships which will allow them to gain a more comprehensive and complete understanding

of gender issues.

- The Centre will celebrate women achievers by commemorating significant days throughout the year.
- A book will be released based on the research project on "Empowering Widows" undertaken by students and teachers in the previous academic year.
- The Centre will encourage students to undertake more research projects related to gender studies so that students can further understand various aspects related to gender studies.
- The Centre will conduct an Add On course in collaboration with different national and state run NGOs to create awareness amongst the students about varied issues pertaining to gender.
- In March, the Centre will commemorate international Women's Day with a variety of activities.
