2nd March 2021

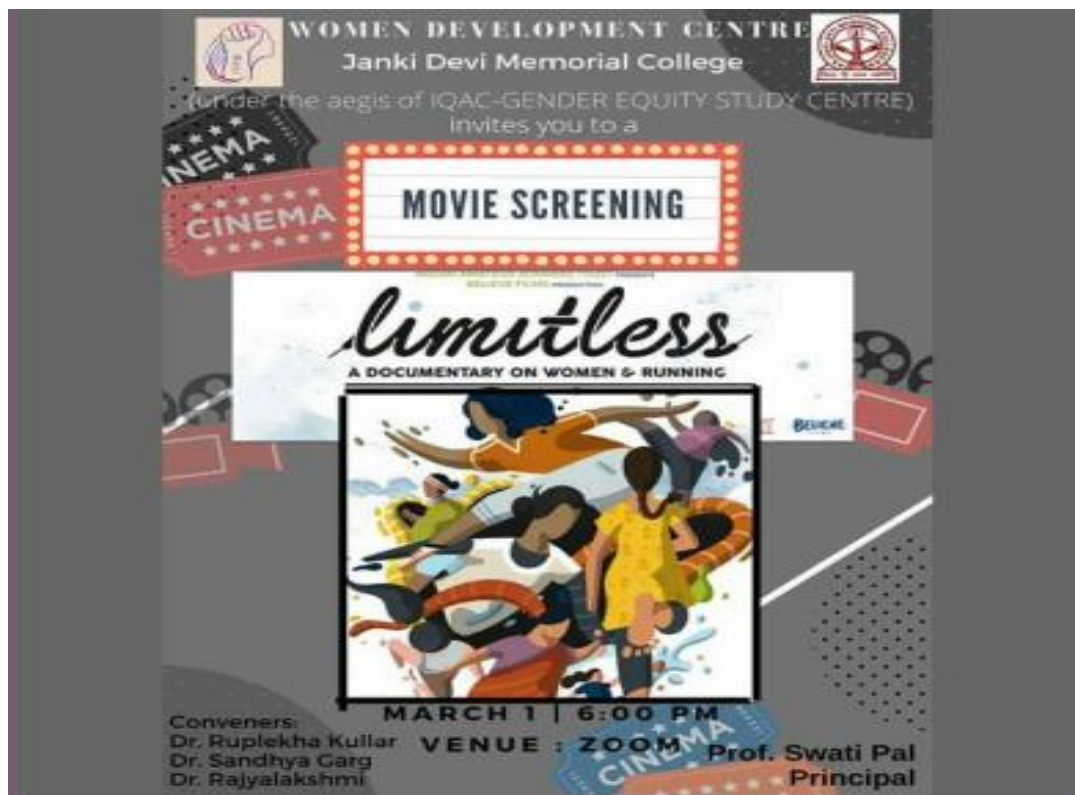

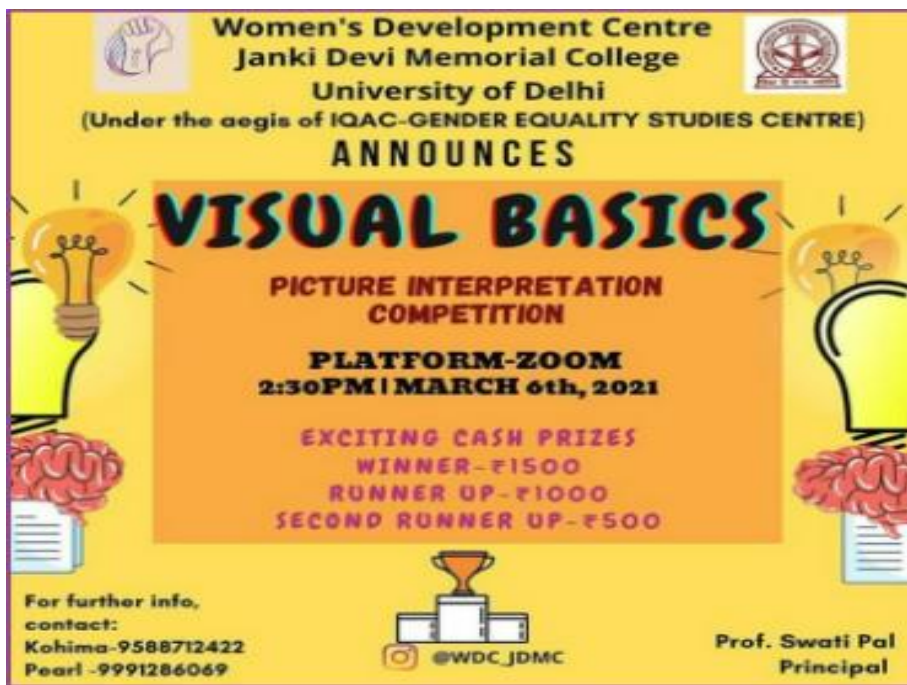
